**Notice Pursuant to Department of Transportation Regulations
49 CFR-192-16**

As your natural gas supplier, CHOUTEAU PWA, is required to inform you: The piping from the gas meter structure(s) or gas utilization equipment is the responsibility of the property owner to maintain.

If you have such piping, you should have the piping periodically inspected for leaks. If the piping is metallic (made of steel) it should also be inspected for corrosion. If any unsafe condition is found, it should be repaired. Plumber and heating contractors are excellent resources for the inspection and maintenance of your piping, a listing of these contractors are available from the Chouteau Public Works Authority.

When excavating near buried gas piping, the piping should be located in advance and the excavation should be done by hand. You may contact your state's One-Call System for assistance in locating the buried piping.
